We invite proposals from Arts & Science faculty and/or units for the Advancing Teaching & Learning in Arts & Science initiatives fund and the Teaching Stream Pedagogical Grants.

Advancing Teaching & Learning in Arts & Science (ATLAS) – Application deadline has been extended to February 21

ATLAS funding supports a wide range of unit-level teaching and learning initiatives within the Faculty of Arts & Science at the undergraduate and graduate levels. ATLAS funding is available for both smaller (up to \$5,000) and larger scale (over \$5,000) projects.

ATLAS proposals must indicate the overall goals and outcomes of the initiative, as well as provide a description of the project and a detailed budget. More details are available at:

Teaching Stream Pedagogical Grants (TSPG) – Upcoming deadlines: March 19 and June 25

Teaching-stream faculty with full-time continuing appointments in the Faculty of Arts & Science are invited to apply for a TSPG grant. Amounts up to \$2,000/fiscal year (May-April) may be requested (through one or more applications) to support teaching and learning research, classroom experimentation and professional development activities. Normally, total expenses will be shared between this grant and the academic unit.

TSPG proposals must include a short overview and rationale for the funding request, including supporting evidence, anticipated benefits for the participating faculty members and students, the academic unit and/or Faculty of Arts & Science as a whole and a detailed budget.
